The Players

From late 2021 to fall 2022, ConcordTV created an original feature length documentary "The Players - The 95-Year History of the Community Players of Concord NH". The community-based project included 24 live interviews, archival footage and over 1,200 vintage photos capturing the story of a "little theatre that grew up

in hard times, learned from the pros, found a home and became a NH resource."

Supported by a grant from NH Humanities, the 96-minute film premiered Sept. 21, 2022 as the season opener of Concord's Walker Lecture Series at Concord City Auditorium. View it at ConcordNHTV on YouTube!


